

## CIH LEVEL 4 CERTIFICATE IN MANAGING HOUSING MAINTENANCE

#### **Course Duration**

The course is normally delivered with 2 or 3 classroom days per unit (6 units are required to gain the Certificate) over a 12 month period - this can be adjusted to suit the level and needs of the candidates and employers.

# What is this programme designed to achieve?

Candidates will develop skills and knowledge that are applicable to the management of housing repairs and maintenance.

# Aims & outcomes

- Provide housing staff working at or aspiring to a supervisory or management level with a qualification to suit their needs
- Develop skills and knowledge for the current challenges in housing and responsive repairs
- Prepare learners for further study in housing related qualifications at level 5 / under graduate level.

# What will I study?

The course focuses on 6 units of study. All students complete the following unit:

Professional Practice skills for housing

## And 5 of the following optional units:

- Procurement and contract administration for responsive repairs
- Performance management for responsive repairs
- Data and performance management for planned maintenance
- Procurement and contract administration for planned maintenance programmes of work.
- Financial management for repairs and maintenance
- Housing Management Services.
- Managing people and change
- Health and safety for repairs and maintenance
- Legal framework for repairs and maintenance
- Sustainable repairs and maintenance
- Customer service in housing
