

CIOB CHARTERED MEMBERSHIP PROGRAMME



What is it?

This course is designed to meet the needs of experienced candidates and is a route to becoming a Chartered Construction Manager with the Chartered Institute of Building (CIOB).



How Long Is It?

The programme is typically delivered in 9 days over a 7/8 month period, leading to an 'open book' assessment in June or November, although this can be tailored to meet company requirements.



Who is eligible?

Candidates will typically have the equivalent of 5 years' experience in managing people, processes & technology in a construction based environment. Training LMS can assist with determining this at an early stage to confirm your eligibility.

The programme is suited for those who may not necessarily have a strong academic background.

How is it delivered?

Candidates will be tutored in four modules focused on a project scenario:

- Health & Safety
- Construction Technology
- Management
- Contract and Commercial Practice

Each module comprises 2 days applying theory to the project scenario with a 1 day workshop during the assessment period. On successful completion of the assessment, candidates will then attend a 2 day workshop to complete the Professional Review, the final step in becoming fully chartered with the CIOB.

Is it for me?

The emphasis on this programme is to build on the management and technical experience candidates have gained in the industry throughout their career. An academic background is not required, and comprehensive guidance is given at every stage.
