

CERTIFICATE & DIPLOMA IN CONSTRUCTION SITE MANAGEMENT VIA WEBINAR

WHAT IS IT?

The CIOB Level 4 Certificate and Diploma in Site Management are qualifications that have been developed to provide career progression and increased promotion prospects.

The Certificate is gained after the successful completion of three modules and the Diploma after all nine.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

The course provides training and qualifications in site management for those who want to be or might already be employed in a managerial position. Candidates come from a wide range of backgrounds, from main contractors, subcontractors, clients and housing associations

HOW IS IT DELIVERED?

Units typically consist of three or four one-hour pre-recorded webinars (these are regularly updated). Candidates gain access to all webinars in a Unit at the same time, and work through them in their own time.

Assessment is via practical assignments, and a hand in date is provided for each unit. Candidates can avail of a live one to one online tutorial with one of the course tutors during each Unit to ask questions and seek further guidance.

Feedback is given for each assignment.

WHAT IS INVOLVED?

The Certificate requires completion of the Managing Health, Safety and Wellbeing Unit and any two additional Units.

The Diploma requires completion of all nine units. Candidates can select individual units should they only wish to complete the Certificate.
